Summary of Results by Strand

The breakdown by strand shows where you have performed well and areas where you may need to do some additional work.

Percentile Rank

The percentile rank gives three comparisons. You are ranked against the students from within your school who sat the test, against all students in Middle East taking the test and against an international sample. For example, a school percentile of 44.1 means that the score is equal to or better than 44.1% of the students from the school taking the particular test. Similar interpretations can be made from the Middle East and international percentiles.

Scaled Score

The scaled score enables you to track your performance between years, as every result will be shown on a common ruler. This means that not only can you compare how you have performed against other groups by looking at the percentiles for any one year but that you can see what progress you are making as an individual between different classes. For example, if your score improves from 200 to 250 over twelve months and then moves from 250 to 350 over the next year this indicates that you have made more progress in the second year.
